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SPECTACLE "THE 'IN' FAIR"

"La 'In' Justa" is a show that stands out for its beauty, realism and constant interaction between the performers and the set pieces.

When the kingdom is in peril, its King, fearful for the fate of his daughter and his lands, decides to seek a worthy successor to the throne from amongst the kingdom's most battle-hardened knights. To determine who possesses the finest qualities, he organises a spectacular joust, in which the knights must face off against one another until the King reaches a decision. But Princess Ingrid is not happy with this sudden obligation to marry, considering that what is taking place is an 'In' Justa, and she tries to discourage the knights with her scathing remarks until one of them makes her an offer that does seem to interest her.

The show 'The "In" Tournament' features a group of SIX MEDIEVAL KNIGHTS, clad in their battle armour, and SIX HORSES whose saddlecloths and metallic details match those of the knight riding them. The horses are steered using Segways, concealed beneath the saddlecloths; thanks to the sound effects they are equipped with, this creates the impression that they are real horses. Segway's X2 models are designed for all terrains and are highly manoeuvrable; with the modifications made for the show, they can be driven hands-free, giving the operators greater freedom of movement to interact with the audience.

Following them, a small TOWER mounted on a motorised chassis concealed beneath its base will make its way through the crowd. Upon the tower stand THE KING and THE PRINCESS, who are responsible for deciding which Knights will duel to prove themselves worthy of fighting for the Kingdom. Both are equipped with an 'In-Head' sound system, through which they will narrate the unfolding events.

Each horse is fitted with a powerful sound system, thanks to which – via a transmission and reception system (the tower acts as the transmitter) – a soundtrack will play in unison, transporting the audience back to the Middle Ages and encouraging them to join in with cheers and shouts of encouragement during each confrontation.
